Ana Tzarev's 'Love & Peace'

Art, Bayfront, Exhibitions, Things to do, Things to see

If you're curious about the sight of a massive 15-foot fiberglass poppy outside the ArtScience Museum, it's part of 76-year-old Croatian artist Ana Tzarev's global 'Love & Peace' campaign, which is being marketed as the 'world's largest ever art installation'. The sculpture is one of several that is being exhibited simultaneously at 15 different places around the world, including London, Venice, New York and Istanbul.

For Singapore, Tzarev specifically chose an amethyst edition (one of five shades of the flower, named after the gem stone), as she has friends and family living here. The purpose of the overall piece, according to the artist, is to spread 'peace, love and understanding' with the flowers acting as rallying points. Viewers are also encouraged to get involved by sharing their photos and stories on Instagram with the hashtag #lovepeaceflower or through a specially-developed Love&Peace free app for both the iPhone and Android.
